



JOINT STATEMENT

GLOBAL COLLABORATION NETWORKING PROGRAM FOR MARINE INDUSTRY

In the spirit of collaboration among international partners; the representatives from Gyeongsangnam-do Province, Korea, and the Region of Baleares, Spain and the State of Queensland, Australia, and the State of Florida, USA, and the State of Rio de Janeiro, Brazil have today discussed mutual collaboration to further develop recreational marine industry in each region. All the representatives recognize the importance of the marine sector to their respective economies; and acknowledge the value of government and industry cooperation as a means to advance business transactions.

The Joint Statement aims to build better commercial and people to people links among each region. Under the Joint Statement, each region will endeavor to develop the following joint activities
